WHEREAS, the Annual Budget as introduced reflects Total Revenues of \$ 185,397 Total Appropriations, including any Accumulated Deficit if any, of \$ 376,590 and Total Unrestricted Net Position utilized of \$ 185,394 ; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget as introduced reflects Total Capital Appropriations of \$ 0 and Total Unrestricted Net Position planned to be utilized as funding thereof, of \$ 0; and

WHEREAS, the schedule of rates, fees and other charges in effect will produce sufficient revenues, together with all other anticipated revenues to satisfy all obligations to the holders of bonds of the Authority, to meet operating expenses, capital outlays, debt service requirements, and to provide for such reserves, all as may be required by law, regulation or terms of contracts and agreements; and

WHEREAS, the Capital Budget/Program, pursuant to N.J.A.C. 5:31-2, does not confer any authorization to raise or expend funds; rather it is a document to be used as part of the said Authority's planning and management objectives. Specific authorization to expend funds for the purposes described in this section of the budget, must be granted elsewhere; by bond resolution, by a project financing agreement, by resolution appropriating funds from the Renewal and Replacement Reserve or other means provided by law.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the governing body of the Passaic County Improvement Authority, at an open public meeting held on September 25, 2019 that the Annual Budget, including all related schedules, and the Capital Budget/Program of the Passaic County Improvement Authority for the fiscal year beginning, January 1, 2019 and ending, December 31, 2019 is hereby approved; and

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, a regular meeting of the Passaic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") was held on September 25, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the Authority adopted a certain bond resolution on August 27, 2008, as amended and supplemented, pursuant to which the Authority issued \$8,587,000 original aggregate principal amount of "The Passaic County Improvement Authority County Guaranteed Governmental Loan Revenue Bonds, Series 2009" (the "Bonds"), issued to fund a loan to Borough of Haledon ("Haledon") and the Borough of Ringwood ("Ringwood") for various purposes; and

WHEREAS, the Ringwood portion of the Bonds are currently outstanding in the aggregate principal amount of \$2,672,000 (which amount excludes the Bonds maturing on October 1, 2019) and mature on October 1, 2020 in the principal amount of \$375,000, October 1, 2021 in the principal amount of \$400,000, October 1, 2022 in the principal amount of \$625,000, October 1, 2023 in the principal amount of \$630,000 and October 1, 2024 in the principal amount of \$642,000 (the "PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds"); and

WHEREAS, Ringwood has requested that the Authority refund and legally defease the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds (the "Project"); and

WHEREAS, the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds shall be paid, with proceeds provided by Ringwood and deposited with TD Bank, National Association, as escrow agent (the "Escrow Agent") pursuant to an escrow deposit agreement (the "Escrow Deposit Agreement") to be entered into by and among the Authority, Ringwood and the Escrow Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to cause the refunding and legal defeasance of the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds as requested by Ringwood, and to do all things necessary for the refunding and legal defeasance of the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds;

WHEREAS, the Authority will require the provision of certain professional services and will incur certain expenses with reference to the proposed project financing in conjunction with the Project;

WHEREAS, the award and approval of professional services and expenses in connection with the Project are exempt from the public bidding requirements;

WHEREAS, the New Jersey Election Law, specifically N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.4, permits, but does not require, a contract with an anticipated value in excess of \$17,500, to be awarded through a "fair and open" process; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has advertised certain contracts potentially exceeding that amount on its official website and issued a request for qualifications in sufficient time to give notice in advance of the contract; and

WHEREAS, certain contracts potentially exceeding \$17,500 are being awarded under a process that provides for public solicitation of qualifications and awarded and disclosed under criteria established in writing by the Authority prior to the solicitation of qualifications; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has publicly opened the responses to the requests for qualifications; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined that the process it has used to award certain contracts potentially exceeding \$17,500 is a "fair and open" process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. (a) The Authority does hereby, as applicable, award, approve, and authorize payment for the following to render professional services and/or provide services in connection with the Project or to the Authority in conjunction with the Project, such payments specifically subject to final approval of the Project by the Authority:

- (b) The Secretary of the Authority is hereby authorized and directed to have published a brief notice of this award in accordance with the provisions of N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a)(i).
- (c) The funds for the services shall be paid out of the proceeds of the Bonds or other project monies and not from the general budget/operating fund(s) of the Authority.
- (d) This award shall apply to the Project, regardless if the Project ultimately consists of defeasance, refunding, or combination thereof of any and all of the outstanding bonds, regardless of whether Ringwood or Haledon is the borrower.

Section 2. The Authority's Chairman is hereby authorized and directed to negotiate and execute an appropriate professional services agreement for the appointments made in Section 1 of this Resolution.

Section 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.

WITNESSETH

WHEREAS, the Passaic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") has been duly created by resolution of the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Passaic, duly adopted December 31, 2002, as a public body corporate and politic of the State of New Jersey pursuant to and in accordance with the County Improvement Authorities Law, constituting Chapter 183 of the Pamphlet Laws of 1960, of the State of New Jersey (the "State"), and the acts amendatory thereof and supplemental thereto (the "Act"); and

WHEREAS, the Authority adopted a certain bond resolution on August 27, 2008, as amended and supplemented, pursuant to which the Authority issued \$8,587,000 original aggregate principal amount of "The Passaic County Improvement Authority County Guaranteed Governmental Loan Revenue Bonds, Series 2009" (the "Bonds"), issued to fund a loan to Borough of Haledon ("Haledon") and the Borough of Ringwood ("Ringwood") for various purposes; and

WHEREAS, the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds shall be paid, with proceeds provided by Ringwood and deposited with TD Bank, National Association, as escrow agent (the "Escrow Agent") pursuant to an escrow deposit agreement (the "Escrow Deposit Agreement") to be entered into by and among the Authority, Ringwood and the Escrow Agent; and

WHEREAS, the Authority has determined to cause the refunding and legal defeasance of the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds as requested by Ringwood, and to do all things necessary for the refunding and legal defeasance of the PCIA/Ringwood Defeased Bonds;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY, AS FOLLOWS:

- 1.
