# RESOLUTION OF THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY APPOINTING CERTAIN PROFESSIONALS AND AUTHORIZING CERTAIN FEES IN CONNECTION WITH ONE OR MORE SERIES OF THE AUTHORITY'S BONDS ISSUED IN CONNECTION WITH THE CITY OF PATERSON BOARD OF EDCUATION'S ENERGY SAVINGS IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (PATERSON ESIP PROGRAM), SERIES 2020

- WHEREAS, a regular meeting of the Passaic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") was held on April 22, 2020; and
- WHEREAS, the City of Paterson Board of Education (the "Borrower") is a political subdivision of the State; and
- WHEREAS, Borrower desires to finance certain energy improvements, pursuant to an Energy Savings Improvement Program;
- WHEREAS, in furtherance of the purposes of the Act and as an inducement to the Borrower to (a) finance the Paterson ESIP Program, and (b) finance costs of issuance in connection with the Bonds described herein (collectively, the "Project"), the Authority desires to assist the Borrower in the financing of the Project;
- WHEREAS, the County Improvement Authorities Law, N.J.S.A. 40:37A-44 et seq. provides that the Authority shall have the power to borrow money and issue its bonds and to provide for the rights of the holders of its bonds;
- WHEREAS, the Authority proposes to issue one or more series of bonds in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$20 Million (the "Bonds") and to apply the proceeds of the Bonds to make a loan to the Borrower for the financing of the Project;
- WHEREAS, the Authority will require the provision of certain professional services and will incur certain expenses with reference to the proposed project financing in conjunction with the Project;
- **WHEREAS**, the award and approval of professional services and expenses in connection with the Project are exempt from the public bidding requirements of the Local Public Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 40A:11-1 et seq.; and
- **WHEREAS,** the Authority has determined that the process it has used to award the contracts necessary for this Series 2020 Project is a "fair and open" process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7.
- NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Authority does hereby, as applicable, award, approve, and authorize payment for the following to render professional services and/or provide services in connection with the Project or to the Authority in conjunction with the Project, such payments specifically subject to final approval of the Project by the Authority:

Section 4. The Chairman is authorized and directed to execute any and all documents necessary to effectuate the above.

Section 5. These contracts are awarded without competitive bidding as a "Professional Service" in accordance with N.J.S.A. 40A:11-5(1)(a) of the Local Public Contracts Law because the contract is for a service performed by a person(s) authorized by law to practice a recognized profession that is regulated by law.

Section 6. The Authority has determined that the process it has used to award the contracts in excess of \$17,500 is a "fair and open" process, pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:44A-20.7.
