- 3. The section in italics under the "Major development" definition should be removed, as this is guidance and not actually part of the Model Stormwater Control Ordinance provided by NJDEP.
- 4. The section in italics under Section 29-5.3.B. should be removed, as this is guidance and not actually part of the Model Stormwater Control Ordinance provided by NJDEP.
- 5. At the bottom of Table 1, there is a reference to notes on page D-15; this reference should be removed or modified as there are no page numbers in the document.
- 6. Under section 29-5.4.M., it should state "Passaic County Office of the County Clerk"; the following section in italics should be removed; the section stating "a form of deed notice shall be submitted to the" is repeated twice and should also be removed.
- Under section 29-5.4.N., the work "appropriate" should be removed between "Passaic County" and "Office of the County Clerk"; the following section in italics should also be removed.
- 8. Under section 29-5.9.A.3., it should be specified how many copies of submission materials the Borough will require applicants to submit.

9. The section in italics under section 29-5.10.8. should be removed, as this is guidance and not actually part of the Model Stormwater Control Ordinance provided by NJDEP.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Ordinance has been granted unconditional approval by the Passaic County Planning Board and shall be considered effective as of March 2, 2021.
