Approval of minutes

Reports:

Monitoring Committee, McFarlane reported that 8 programs have been monitored. McFarlane reported the monitoring committee met on May 21, 2021 to review the new monitoring tool and procedures. The next monitoring committee meeting is scheduled for June 25, 2021. McFarlane also requested volunteers for a monitor that was scheduled for tomorrow at 12:30 pm.

Allocations Committee, Starr reported that the committee did not meet and will reconvene in July.

Planning Committee, McCombs reported that the planning committee will be meeting monthly. The meetings will be held the 1st Wednesday of each month at 11:00 AM.

Education, Training, and Advocacy Committee, Starr reported that the committee was not able to meet and will report at the next YSC meeting.

Youth Services Commission Administrators, Starr reported on the importance of monitoring. It has become difficult to create monitoring teams with the new requirements by JJC. Starr encouraged nonfunded YSC members to participate in at least one monitor.

JJC (Juvenile Justice Commission) Compton-Dover reported Compton-Dover stated that there were changes with the monitoring sub-committee and the monitoring teams. "If you are a non-funded member, we really need you to sign up for monitoring". The new monitoring tool will be on an average of a score, so the more people who attend the more visions the more accurate of a score we can get. Compton-Dover expressed the importance of when the email to sign up for monitoring goes out keep in mind that it is necessary and is required and they must get done for the Plan Update.

Juvenile Detention Alternatives Initiative,

Executive Committee, Butterfield reiterated that the committee met last week and discussed today's agenda and discussed having more members join the sub-committees. If folks do not sign up, they will be chosen to join.

New Business

Larry Alvarez spoke about the importance of cultural competence when working with youth and families, Larry expressed concern for Spanish speaking youth who have may have limited access to services due to a lack of multilingual staffing.
