What is Register Ready?

Register Ready is a free, secure, voluntary database designed to help emergency managers and first responders plan for and support people with disabilities and access and functional needs (DAFN) who may need assistance in the event of a disaster.

You (or someone on your behalf) are encouraged to register if you have a physical, developmental, cognitive or behavioral impairment, language barrier, or transportation challenge that may make it difficult for you to safely shelter in place or evacuate in a disaster.

Who should register?

Permanent and seasonal NJ residents with DAFN who may need help evacuating, sheltering in place or at a public shelter, or requiring emergency assistance should register. Individuals with a temporary disability, such as high-risk pregnancy or other serious medical condition, should register.



2020 Hurricane Season is Here!

The Atlantic hurricane season is expected to be an active one this year, so be prepared:

- Three day supply of canned, non-perishable, ready-to-eat FOOD
- Three day supply of WATER (a total of three gallons per family member)
- Battery-operated RADIO and extra batteries
- FLASHLIGHT and extra batteries
- One week prescription MEDICATIONS
- FIRST AID KIT
- Personal TOILETRIES

- Non-electric CAN OPENER and UTENSILS
- SPECIAL NEEDS items:
 - * INFANT care items
 - * Items for ELDERLY family members
 - * Items for relatives with DISABILITIES
- CASH or TRAVELERS CHECKS
- Pet Supplies
- Store important **DOCUMENTS** in a waterproof, safe location

Passaic County Farmers' Market

The Passaic County Farmers' Market operates from June through November

The program provides eligible low-income individuals with vouchers to purchase fresh, nutritious, unprepared, locally grown fruits, vegetables and fresh cut herbs from certified farmers and roadside stands. The program reinforces the importance of using locally grown produce and expands the awareness and use of the local farmers. Each eligible individual will receive six \$5.00 vouchers for the season to purchase fresh fruits, vegetables and herbs from authorized farmers. Vouchers cannot be redeemed at grocery stores.

Requirements

To be eligible to receive Farmers' Market Nutrition Program benefits, individuals must be at least 60 years old, a Passaic County resident and meet the program's income requirements. All individuals must complete an application. For income requirements, please contact Senior Services at 973-569-4060.

The State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) is a statewide program administered by the New Jersey Department of Human Services with financial assistance through a grant from the U.S. Administration for Community Living (ACL). Currently in the Nation there are 59 million Medicare beneficiaries and includes people who are 65 and older and people who have a permanent disability. Many have difficulty navigating Medicare and the health care system on their own. Some do not get the care they need because they cannot pay and do not know about programs that provide help. Others, (the many caregivers who assist family members, friends and neighbors) need answers and guidance. SHIP counselors provide free one-on-one Medicare counseling.
