Update, January 4, 2022

*Please Note*: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers and Therapeutic Recreation staff distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

This is written to provide an Update as of January 4, 2022 of the Outbreak that began on November 29, 2021:

- Fourteen residents tested positive.
  - o Thirteen residents are fully vaccinated; nine had a booster
  - Two residents were hospitalized; one resident returned from the hospital
- Ninety-seven staff tested positive. The last positive results were on January 4, 2022.
  - o Seventy-six staff who tested positive are fully vaccinated
  - One staff is partially vaccinated
  - o Eighteen staff had a booster
  - o Twenty-four staff have returned to work or are cleared to return on January 5, 2022
- Five visitors tested positive.

Preliminary analysis of staff who tested positive include:

o C NAs and related staff: 34

Dietary staff: 22

o Security: 4

Social Services: 3

Therapeutic Recreation: 5

Environmental Services: 7

o Admissions: 1

Buildings and Grounds: 4Respiratory Therapy: 2

o Rehabilitation: 1

o Clerical: 2

Our Director of Nursing and Infection Preventionist contact-trace the exposure of residents by staff who test positive and review with our Medical Director to establish testing timeframes and transmission-based precautions. Nursing staff continue to contact the designated representatives for residents who were exposed to the staff within a 48-hour timeframe. Daniel Nasulme, Director of Nursing (973-585-1409) or Tina Hucalla, Infection Preventionist (973-585-2181) may be called to discuss specific

circumstances. Residents who test positive reside on resident unit 2-400 "C" during the fourteen day quarantine period.

COVID vaccinations for residents and staff for first, second or booster doses are scheduled as we have enough residents and/or staff who wish to be vaccinated to use a full vial of the vaccine to avoid wasting doses of the vaccine. Five residents received vaccines on January 3, 2022. Vaccination questions or messages may be left on the phone number dedicated to COVID-19 vaccination: **973-585-2100.** We encourage all residents, staff and visitors to be vaccinated and receive a booster dose if eligible. Unvaccinated staff are tested twice/week. Antigen testing is available for visitors who wish to be tested.

We will celebrate Kwanza with a special lunch on January 6, 2022.
