Update, May 19, 2022 Celebrating Asian American and Pacific Islander Heritage Month

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers and Therapeutic Recreation staff distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

This Update is written to inform you that one staff tested positive for COVID-19 since the last Update. On May 18, 2022, a nurse in a supervisory position was informed of a positive test result. The last day of work prior to the test result was May 15, 2022. The current outbreak began on April 18, 2022. Nine staff have tested positive. The nine staff completed the primary series of vaccination. Six of the nine staff received boosters. To date, no residents have tested positive. We continue to follow all precautionary infection prevention measures and regulatory requirements.

Recently, four visitors informed us of positive test results after visiting residents. Residents who were exposed to the visitors were tested. We have antigen tests available for visitors who wish to be tested prior to visiting. If interested, please inform Security staff when you arrive for the entrance screening.

We continue to offer COVID-19 Vaccines to residents and staff in accordance with current CDC recommendations. Please call Patrick Kuiken, RN, Infection Preventionist at 973-585-2181 for additional information.
