PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AUTHORIZING A SHARED SERVICES AGREEMENT BY AND BETWEEN THE COUNTY OF PASSAIC AND THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY FOR GENERAL ACCOUNTING SERVICES, PURSUANT TO N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1, ET SEQ.

WHEREAS, a regular meeting of the Passaic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") was held on April 27, 2022;

WHEREAS, the Authority desires to continue to maintain its books and financial information in an orderly manner;

WHEREAS, the Uniform Shared Services and Consolidation Act, N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., authorizes the Authority to enter into an agreement with any other local unit or units, such as the County, to provide or receive any service that each local unit participating in the agreement is empowered to provide or receive within its own jurisdiction;

WHEREAS, pursuant to the shared services agreement, the County shall provide general accounting services to the Authority for a minimum of five (5) hours per week at the rate of one hundred dollars (\$100.00) per hour, for a monthly amount of two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00);

WHEREAS, the term of the shared services agreement shall be for a period of ten (10) years, beginning May 1, 2022 and expiring April 30, 2032, with the County and the Authority retaining options to terminate same upon sixty (60) days' notice to the other party, upon notice; and

WHEREAS, the Authority desires enter into a shared services agreement, in accordance with the aforementioned terms.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY RESOLVED BY THE MEMBERS OF THE PASSAIC COUNTY IMPROVEMENT AUTHORITY AS FOLLOWS:

- 1. The Authority hereby authorizes a shared services agreement between the Authority and the County, pursuant to the terms set forth in this resolution.
- 2. The Authority professionals and Chairman are authorized and directed to take all appropriate action to enter into a shared services agreement, pursuant to the terms set forth in this resolution.
- 3. This resolution shall take effect immediately.
