Update, December 1, 2022

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers and Therapeutic Recreation staff distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

On November 30, 2022 and December 1, 2022 four residents and six staff tested positive. Our four residents live on resident unit 1-300. Our staff who tested positive include one C NA from resident unit 1-400, three CNAs from resident unit 1-300, one food services worker and one nurse from resident unit 1-400. All residents who tested positive are residing on resident unit 2-400 "C" section until transmission-based precautions are discontinued. We have expanded the testing of staff to include all staff until further notice. All residents who had close contact with the residents or staff who tested positive were tested today and will be retested in accordance with regulatory requirements.

Patrick Kuiken, RN, Infection Preventionist is continuing to administer the bivalent booster vaccines to residents and staff who are eligible to receive the booster and who consent to receive it.

As a reminder to staff, December 31, 2022, is the deadline established by the NJ Department of Health to receive an influenza vaccine or to submit a medical exemption that meets the criteria established by the NJ Department of Health.

Residents' guests who wear a mask completely covering their nose and mouth may participate in the celebrations in the main dining room. Please note: cloth masks are not permitted.

Antigen tests are available for visitors who wish to be tested. Please inform the Security staff when visiting if you wish to be tested.

The Passaic County Board of County Commissioners in collaboration with Passaic County social services agencies are hosting a "Holiday Angel Tree Toy Drive" to provide toys to the YMCA of Paterson, the Paterson Great Falls Military Assistance Program and foster children in Passaic County. Donations of new gifts would be appreciated. The gifts do not need to be wrapped. We will have a receptacle for the gifts in our main entrance lobby and the employee entrance.

The Passaic County Board of County Commissioners in partnership with the NJ Department of Health is offering free COVID-19 test kits for Passaic County residents. There is a limit of two kits/person, while supplies last. The kits can be picked up at the Passaic County Dept of Health Services, 930 Riverview Drive, Suite 250, Totowa, 973-881-4396, Monday to Friday, 9 am to 4 pm.

Next week, we will begin a project to upgrade our fire alarm system in the 200s and 400s sections of our Home. The work will include replacing the smoke detectors that are located throughout these sections of our Home including in resident rooms. We will provide updates of the project schedule/locations as the project progresses.

Weather-permitting, beginning on December 5, 2022 for approximately two weeks, solar panels will be installed over the main entrance areas to access the roofs behind the courtyard. The work areas will be protected. Vehicles will be able to drive to our front entrance canopy to bring visitors/supplies, but not through the circular drive.
