Update, January 5, 2023

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

Since the last Update, four staff tested positive: one Security Guard, one staff from Dietary, one C NA from resident unit 3-200 and one C NA from the Pathway special care nursing facility. Residents and staff who had close contact with the staff who tested positive are tested in accordance with regulatory requirements. Residents who tested positive are residing on unit 2-400 "C" section until transmission-based precautions are discontinued. We currently have three residents on resident unit 2-400 "C".

Since the beginning of the Outbreak on November 23, 2022,

- 65 staff tested positive
 - Sixty-two staff are vaccinated.
 - Eighteen staff received the bivalent booster
- 18 residents tested positive
 - Fifteen residents are vaccinated
 - o Twelve residents received the bivalent booster

The NJ Department of Health continues to urge residents and staff to become vaccinated as the safest and most effective protection against COVID-19 and its variants, noting that the new bivalent vaccine is formulated to work against the original COVID virus and the most recent variant, Omicron. We will have a "vaccine clinic" on January 12, 2023 during the hours that staff are tested for COVID. Residents or staff who wish to receive a vaccine before this date may contact Patrick Kuiken, RN, LTC-CIP, Infection Preventionist who is continuing to administer the vaccines to those who are eligible and who consent to receive a vaccine.
