**Driver Safety Course** 

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By taking the driver refresher course you'll learn the current rules of the road, defensive driving techniques and how to operate your vehicle more safely.

You'll learn how you can manage and accommodate common age-related changes in vision, hearing, and reaction time. You may be eligible to receive an insurance discount upon completing the course, so consult with your insurance agent for details. AARP membership is not required to take the course and there is no test to pass.

All attendees must bring their NJ Driver's License and if they are a member of *AARP*, they need to bring their membership card. Attendees can bring their lunch and snack if they care to. There will be a 30-minute lunch break.



The **Passaic County Division of Home Energy & Weatherization** is helping Passaic County residents to save on their energy bills, by providing utility benefits and providing upgrades that make homes more energy efficient.

The <u>Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP)</u> offers financial assistance to those having difficulty paying their electric, gas and deliverable fuel bills. Applicants must be residents of Passaic County and meet income guidelines

**EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE SEASON:** As of March 15, 2023, clients who are approved for LIHEAP (Home Energy Assistance) and have a shut off notice on their utility bill are <u>automatically eligible</u> for <u>EMERGENCY Assistance</u>. <u>Contact</u> us to find out more about how to apply for emergency assistance on your utility bill!

In addition to our home energy-saving programs, we also provide the <u>Lead Remediation and</u> <u>Abatement Program</u>, to reduce exposure to harmful lead-based paint. If you or someone you know live in a 1 to <u>4 unit</u> property built before 1978, call us to see if you qualify for a free lead inspection.

# **Fall Prevention Program – Good Steps**

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, the problem of falls in adults is a serious one. Each year 3 million

people are treated in emergency departments for a fall and at least 800,000 people are hospitalized each year for a fall related injury including over 300,000 hip fractures.

Did you know that Passaic County ADRC funds a fall prevention program that is free for all county residents over the age of 60 who are at risk for a fall? Working with Home Care Options, this program helps to improve an individual's activity level, balance & endurance and has been shown to decrease falls. The Fall Prevention program is based on the evidence-based Otago Exercise Program, which has been used worldwide.

The program uses an individually tailored program of muscle-strengthening and balance-retraining exercises of increasing difficulty, combined with a walking program.

Specially trained staff from Home Care Options provide the program in each eligible participant's home. During the visits, the staff provides instructions on a set of in-home exercises (selected at appropriate and increasing levels of difficulty) and a walking plan.

Who would benefit from this free program? Anyone who has had a fall or has a medical condition that puts them at risk for a fall. To learn more about the Fall Prevention program please call 973-569-4060.

- CHECK THE MEDICINE CABINET AND GET RID OF EXPIRED, UNUSED MEDICATION. Store medicines in a cool, dry and dark place.

- HAVE AN EMERGENCY PLAN IN PLACE. Know who to call in an emergency and have your phone programmed accordingly.



# **SHIP**

The State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) is a statewide program administered by the New Jersey Department of Human Services with financial assistance through a grant from the U.S. Administration for Community Living (ACL). Currently in the Nation there are 59 million Medicare beneficiaries, including people who are 65 and older and people who have a permanent disability. Many have difficulty navigating Medicare and the health care system on their own. Some do not get the care they need because they cannot pay and do not know about programs that provide help. Others, (the many caregivers who assist family members, friends and neighbors) need answers and guidance. SHIP counselors provide free one-on-one Medicare counseling.
