As previously noted, on February 21, 2023, residents from units 2-400 "B" section and 3-400 "B" section were temporarily transferred to other sections of our Home for a pending fire alarm system repair. After assessing options with fire officials, the work will be included in the project to replace the fire alarm system for the 200s and 400s sections of our Home that was already designed and is pending

regulatory approval to begin the replacement. The duration of the temporary transfer is under review pending the anticipated project start date. Resident rooms that were vacated are reserved for the future return of residents to their rooms.
