With the end of the Public Health Emergency, consistent with regulatory directives and guidance, we are assessing our COVID policies regarding entrance screening, masking and testing and will communicate revisions as we implement the changes.

On May 15, 2023, we were informed that a C NA who works on resident unit 3-400 tested positive on May 13, 2023. The last day our C NA worked was on May 11, 2023. Residents who were exposed to the C NA were tested on May 15, 2023; all results were negative. Residents who were exposed will be retested on May 17, 2023.

Our annual Memorial Day Parade is scheduled for May 24, 2023 at 11:00 am, weather-permitting. As is our tradition, we honor our Veteran residents and staff during our parade and encourage family members to celebrate with us. Visitors who wish to park in the main parking lot should arrive by 10:00 am.
