Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

On August 16, 2023, one resident who lives on our Pathway Unit tested positive. Residents and staff who had close contact with our resident were tested. All staff who work on the Pathway unit are in the process of being tested. Residents who tested positive are residing on resident unit 2-300 until the completion of the period for transmission-based precautions. Residents and staff who had close contact with a resident or staff who tested positive will continue to be tested in accordance with requirements. We currently have six residents and two staff who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19.

Last evening, we had our second "Movie Under the Stars" event. Thank you to Kerry Klug, Passaic County Parks Department who brought the event to us and to our staff who assisted in our outdoor movie "theatre".
