Update, August 25, 2023

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

Since the start of the current COVID outbreak on August 15, 2023, nine residents and ten staff have tested positive.

Residents and staff who had close contact with residents or staff who tested positive will continue to be tested in accordance with requirements. Residents who tested positive are residing on unit 2-300 until the completion of the period for transmission-based precautions.
