

The Low Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP & USF) offers financial assistance to individuals having difficulty paying their electric, gas and deliverable fuel bills.

This year, the Passaic County Home Energy Assistance Program will be accepting applications <u>beginning in September 2023.</u>

Applicants must be residents of Passaic County and meet income guidelines.

You may qualify whether you own or rent, live in a single family home, multifamily housing complex or in a mobile home.

Stay Well This Fall

Tips to help you avoid getting sick:

- Get a flu shot and COVID-19 vaccine.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick. If you're sick, limit contact with others to keep from infecting them.
- Cover coughs and sneezes. Cover your nose and mouth with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. Throw the tissue in the trash after you use it.

- Use hand sanitizer if soap and water are not available.
- Wash your hands often with soap and water. Scrub your hands for at least 20 seconds. Not sure how long that is? Hum Happy Birthday twice. Be sure to lather the backs of your hands, between your fingers, and under your nails.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth. Germs spread this way.
- Clean and disinfect surfaces and objects that may be contaminated with viruses.

The State Health Insurance Assistance Program (SHIP) is a statewide program administered by the New Jersey Department of Human Services with financial assistance through a grant from the U.S. Administration for Community Living (ACL). Currently in the Nation there are 59 million Medicare beneficiaries, including people who are 65 and older and people who have a permanent disability. Many have difficulty navigating Medicare and the health care system on their own. Some do not get the care they need because they cannot pay and do not know about programs that provide help. Others, (the many caregivers who assist family members, friends and neighbors) need answers and guidance. SHIP counselors provide free one-on-one Medicare counseling.
