Update, September 6, 2023

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

The current Outbreak began on August 15, 2023. On September 5, 2023 one resident who lives on resident unit 3-400 and six residents on unit 2-200 tested positive. During the fourth cycle of testing of residents on unit 3-400 on September 6, 2023, one resident tested positive. Residents who live on unit 2-200 will be retested on September 7 and on September 9, 2023. One nursing staff who works on unit 2-200 tested positive on September 5, 2023 and two nursing staff who work on unit 3-400 tested positive on September 6, 2023.

- o Resident unit 1-300, Five residents
- o Resident unit 2-200: Six residents
- Pathway unit, Three residents

- One resident was hospitalized.
- o Ten residents completed transmissions-based precautions and returned to their units.
- Residents who tested positive are residing on unit 2-300 until the completion of the period for transmission-based precautions.
