Update, October 6, 2023

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

The month of October is Breast Cancer Awareness month. We will "pink out" on October 13, 2023 and October 20, 2023 to show our encouragement and support to those with breast cancer or who are in remission. Please see the posted flyers for the details.

On October 4, 2023, one C NA who works on resident unit 2-400 tested positive for COVID-19. Residents who had close contact were tested and will be retested in accordance with regulatory requirements. On October 6, 2023, one Dietary employee tested positive. Since the beginning of the current COVID-19 Outbreak on August 15, 2023, 33 residents and 29 staff have tested positive. The 29 staff include four staff who were not considered cases of the Outbreak. We currently do not have any residents who are on transmission-based precautions for COVID-19.

As recommended by the NJ Department of Health, we are preparing to administer the updated COVID-19 booster doses to residents who consent or who have consent authorized by the resident's representative to receive the vaccine. Patrick Kuiken, RN, LTC-CIP, Infection Preventionist is in the process of calling resident representatives and speaking with residents who make their own decisions to obtain consent to receive the COVID-19, influenza and/or RSV vaccines. He can be reached at 973-585-2181 for additional information or to answer any questions. We are still finalizing arrangements to obtain the COVID-19 vaccines. As a reminder, staff must receive an influenza vaccine or have an exemption that meets the New Jersey regulatory requirements before December 31, 2023. Please direct any questions to Mr. Kuiken.
