**RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING SHARED SERVICE AGREEMENTS
BETWEEN PASSAIC COUNTY HEALTH DEPARTMENT AND THE
VARIOUS NAMED MUNICIPALITIES, FOR PUBLIC HEALTH
PREPAREDNESS AND RESPONSE TO BIOTERRORISM
OUTBREAKS OF INFECTION DISEASE, AND OTHER PUBLIC
HEALTH THREATS AND EMERGENCIES**

WHEREAS the Passaic County Board of Chosen Freeholders has created the Passaic County Department of Health pursuant to N.J.S.A. 26:3A2-1 et seq., and the County Environmental Health Act (CEHA) N.J.S.A. 26:3A 2-21 et seq., to provide an array of public services; and

WHEREAS the New Jersey Department of Health has designated the PCDH as the Local Information Network and Communication System – LINCS – agency for Passaic County; and

WHEREAS the LINCS Agency has applied for a Local Core Capacity Infrastructure for Bioterrorism Preparedness Grant with in the New Jersey Department of Health; and

WHEREAS in the interest of homeland security, effective and coordinated countywide public health systems must be created utilizing the valuable assets, talent and experience residing in the local health departments throughout the State; and

WHEREAS the Local Core Capacity infrastructure for Bioterrorism Preparedness Grant requires shared service agreements between the PCDH and local health departments to cooperatively work to plan and implement approved activities and work plan for Passaic County; and

WHEREAS the named Municipalities in the attached list are desirous of having their respective Local Health Departments, cooperatively work with the LINCS Agency for the planning and

implementation of State approved services/activities for bioterrorism, infectious disease outbreaks, and other public health threats and emergencies preparedness and response for Passaic County; and

WHEREAS the parties to these respective agreements are authorized to contract for said shared services pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:65-1 et seq., and

WHEREAS this matter was reviewed and approved by the Health, Education and Community Services Committee on March 7, 2017;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOVLED that the Board of Chosen Freeholders of the County of Passaic hereby authorizes the County to enter into Shared Services Agreements between the Passaic County Department of Health and the designated Municipalities named in the attached list, for Public Health Preparedness and Response to Bioterrorism, outbreaks of infection disease, and other public health threats and emergencies; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Board hereby authorizes the Director and Clerk to execute any necessary documents on behalf of the County of Passaic.
