Update, December 15, 2023

Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

Thank you for the Passaic County Sheriff's Christmas Light Spectacular Truck Parade's visit in the "snow" with our residents on December 11, 2023! It certainly helped to get us into the holiday spirit.

Since the beginning of the Outbreak on October 17, 2023, twenty-nine residents and eighteen staff have tested positive. We currently have eight residents on unit 2-400 "C" who are completing the transmission-based precautions period for COVID-19. *The phone number for unit 2-400 is 973-317-7031*. Three staff tested positive on December 12, 2023: two staff from Therapeutic Recreation and one staff from nursing management. Three staff are on transmission-based precautions. Residents and staff who had exposure to residents or staff who tested positive or who have symptoms are tested in accordance with regulatory requirements. Antigen tests are available at no cost for visitors who wish to be tested. Please inform the Security staff when visiting if you wish to be tested.

Please be advised that until further notice, staff must wear masks at all times. Visitors and residents are strongly encouraged to wear masks.
