Correction (to number of residents on transmission-based precautions)

Please Note: This Update is posted on the Passaic County website and distributed through the Constant Contact email group for families who have elected to provide their email address and is distributed to all staff. Our Social Workers, Therapeutic Recreation staff and Unit Clerks distribute the Update to residents who wish to receive it.

On February 17, 2024, one resident who lives on unit 1-200 tested positive for COVID-19. We are continuing to retest staff who had close contact and residents of the 1-200 unit in accordance with regulatory guidance. Four residents are residing on resident unit 2-400 "C" section until transmission-based precautions are discontinued. The phone number is 973-317-7031. Two staff are out of work on transmission-based precautions. Antigen tests are available at no cost for visitors who wish to be tested. Please inform the Security staff when visiting if you wish to be tested.

Until further notice, staff must wear masks at all times. Visitors and residents are strongly encouraged to wear masks.

The Passaic County Health Department will offer a COVID-19 Vaccination Clinic in our Home on February 23, 2024 from 2 pm to 4 pm. Staff, family members and friends of our residents are welcome to attend and receive either a Moderna or Pfizer vaccine, regardless of insurance status. In addition, Patrick Kuiken, RN, LTC-CIP, Infection Preventionist is continuing to administer the COVID-19 vaccine to residents who consent or who have consent authorized by the resident's representative to receive the vaccine.
