



# FOR PASSAIC COUNTY VOTERS

## IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING BEFORE ELECTION DAY

Due to a new State law, you now have the option to vote in-person, using a voting machine, during a five-day period prior to Election Day. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 19:15A-1, early voting will begin on the 6th calendar day before a presidential primary election and end on the second calendar day before that presidential primary election. No matter where you live in Passaic County, you can vote your specific ballot on a voting machine at any one of the below designated in-person Early Voting locations.

## Here are the 3 ways you can vote in the upcoming Primary Election...

### 1. AT YOUR POLLING PLACE ON ELECTION DAY



**Vote in person** at your polling place, from 6:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m. on **Election Day, Tuesday, June 4**. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

Go to **VOTE.NJ.GOV** for your polling place, listed on the Polling Locations page.

### 2. IN-PERSON EARLY VOTING



This option enables all registered voters to cast their ballot **in person, using a voting machine, during a five-day period prior to Election Day**. You can choose to vote, in person, when it's most convenient for your schedule.

No matter where you live in the county, you can vote your specific ballot at any of **your** county's designated in-person early voting sites. Find your county's sites at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.

In-person early voting sites will be open **Wednesday, May 29, through Sunday, June 2**. Hours will be **Wednesday–Saturday, 10:00 a.m.–8:00 p.m. and Sunday, 10:00 a.m.–6:00 p.m.** No appointment is necessary. Accommodations will be made for voters with disabilities.

### 3. VOTE BY MAIL



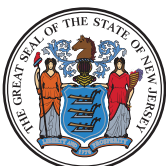
Registered voters can apply for a **mail-in ballot** by following the instructions found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV** or contacting their County Clerk.

Then, VOTE and RETURN your ballot one of the following ways...

- **Secure Ballot Drop Box:** Place your mail-in ballot in one of your county's secure ballot drop boxes by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4. Drop box locations can be found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.
- **Board of Elections Office:** Deliver your mail-in ballot in person to your county's Board of Elections Office by 8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4. County Election Officials' contact information can be found at **VOTE.NJ.GOV**.
- **Mail:** Your mail-in ballot **MUST** be postmarked on or before **8:00 p.m. on Tuesday, June 4** and be received by your county's Board of Elections on or before Monday, June 10.

**NOTE: Mail-in ballots CANNOT be returned to your early voting site or polling place.**
