- Bloomingdale Delazier Field Playground Improvement Project, \$225,0000.00:
 Proposed replacement of outdated playground equipment and adding rubberized surfacing at Delazier Field. Includes upgrades that conform to ADA.
- Clifton Anzaldi Park Improvements, \$225,000.00: Proposed installation of field lighting at Anzaldi Park (AKA Athenia Steel Recreation Complex)
- 3) Haledon Haledon Recreational Center Renovation, \$150,000: Proposed upgrades to the bathrooms and storage rooms at the Haledon Recreation center
- 4) Hawthorne Wagaraw Fields 2 & 3 Bleacher Improvements, \$125,000: Proposed replacement of baseball bleachers with new bleachers at Wagaraw Fields 2 &3. Will include ADA compliant seating.
- 5) Little Falls Louis Park Improvement Project, \$225,000.00: Proposed conversion of an existing baseball domond into a multi-use sports field with fencing and bleachers, resurfacing and refurbishment of an exisiting basketball court, new playground equipment, and a paved parking lot adjacent to the field.
- 6) North Haledon High Mountain School Playground Rehabilitation, \$225,000.00: Proposed replacement of outdated playground equipment and adding rubberized surfacing adjacent to the High Mountain Middle School. Includes upgrades that conform to ADA. Property is confirmed to be owned by North Haledon, not the Board of Education.
- 7) Paterson Multi-Park Improvement Project, \$200,000: Paterson Vietnam Veterans Park: demolition of existing sidewlak, removal of shrubbery and dead trees, reinstallation of concrete sidewalks and concrete pavers, construction of flagpoles, construction of two flowerbeds, installation of eight park benches; Hayden Heights: removal of dead trees; Ralph Di Marcantonio Park: install rubberized surfacing under playground, repair broken water pipe, grade and reseed work areas.
- 8) Pompton Lakes Hershfield Park Improvements Phase II, \$100,000.00: Proposed restoration of playground area and tree plantings around border of site to limit flooding damage from adjacent Wanaque River
- Prospect Park Hofstra Park Tennis, Basketball, and Pickleball Courts Project,
 \$225,000: Proposed resurfacing of the tennis, basketball, and pickleball courts in Hofstra Park.
- Ringwood Stonetown Turf Field, \$225,000: Proposed installation of a turf field at the Stonetown Recreation Complex, field lighting for turf field, and new ADA compliant playground
- 11) **Totowa Washington Park Playground Project, \$193,763.14:** Proposed replacement of outdated playground equipment and adding rubberized surfacing.
- 12) **Wanaque Laurie Field Improvements, \$225,000.00:** Proposed improvements to Laurie Field including: two pickleball courts w/ fencing, sound proofing on fences, guardrail along park entrance to pump house, gravel roadway to pump house, parking spaces on gravel area, gravel walkway, tables and benches, landscaping.
- 13) Wayne Little League D2 Turf Field, \$100,000.00: Proposed turning of the backfield of baseball diamond D2 at Dotterweich Field.

14) Woodland Park – Thomas E. May Memorial Park Improvement Project, \$225,000.00: Repair work to rubberized safety area due to elevation challenges with site, installation of concrete border around playground, installation of more playground equipment
