## NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

Notice is hereby given that a telephonic public hearing will be held by the Passaic County Improvement Authority (the "Authority") on August 15, 2024, commencing at 11:00 a.m., for the purpose of providing a reasonable opportunity for interested persons to express their views both orally and in writing on the proposed issuance by the Authority of Charter School Revenue Bonds (Community Charter School of Paterson Project), Series 2024 (the "Bonds") in an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$18,500,000.

The proceeds of the Bonds will be loaned to Morris Charter, Inc. (the "Borrower"), a New Jersey not-for-profit corporation, and will be used, together with other available monies, to (1) finance the project (the "Project") consisting of (i) acquisition of certain real property consisting of the land and the school facilities built thereon and occupied by Community Charter School of Paterson (the "School"), located at Block 4802, Lots 23 and 24, and commonly known as 2-6 and 8-14 Morris Street in the City of Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey (collectively, the "Project Facilities"), and (ii) undertaking of certain capital improvements at the Project Facilities, (2) funding a debt service reserve fund, and (3) paying certain costs of issuing the Bonds.

The Project will be owned by the Borrower and the Project Facilities will be leased by the Borrower to the School. The Project will be located on land owned by the Borrower and located at Block 4802, Lots 23 and 24 and commonly known as 2-6 and 8-14 Morris Street, in the City of Paterson, Passaic County, New Jersey.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity for persons with differing views on the issuance of the Bonds and the financing of the Project to be heard and to present their oral and written comments. At the time set for the public hearing, pursuant to Internal Revenue Service Revenue Procedure 2022-20, interested persons will be given a reasonable opportunity to express their views, both orally (via telephonic participation) and in writing, on the merits and location of the Project, the plan of financing, the issuance of the Bonds, or related matters.
