A voter may vote by mail for any or all elections by completing an application for a Vote by Mail Ballot and mailing it to the County Clerk up to 7 days before the election.

In New Jersey, using the Vote By Mail ballot, any voter can vote by mail for any reason or no reason at all. A voter can vote by mail for one election or all, depending on his or her preference.




APPLYING FOR A VOTE-BY-MAIL BALLOT

Registered Passaic County voters can apply for a vote-by-mail ballot by contacting the Passaic County Clerk's Office.

- To receive your ballot in the mail, the County Clerk's Office must receive your application by Tuesday, October 29, 2024.
- Voters may apply for a vote-by-mail ballot in person by visiting the County Clerk's Office by 3:00 p.m. on Monday, November 4, 2024.
