

A voter may vote by mail for any or all elections by completing an application for a Vote by Mail Ballot and mailing it to the County Clerk up to 7 days before the election.

In New Jersey, using the Vote By Mail ballot, any voter can **vote by mail for any reason or no reason at all**. A voter can **vote by mail for one election or all**, depending on his or her preference.
